

**THE COMMITTEE ON PREPARATION FOR MINISTRY**

The Committee on Preparation for Ministry moves:

1. in accordance with G-14.0308 that **WADE POND** (a member of First, Lancaster) be continued as an Inquirer.
2. in accordance with G-14.0308 that **DEBBIE HEFFERNAN** (a member of Paoli) be continued as an Inquirer.
3. in accordance with G-14.0310 that **BARBARA WHIPPLE** (a member of Kennett Square) be certified to be ready for examination for ordination, pending a call.
4. in accordance with G-14.0310 that **TIMOTHY DOONER** (a member of Paoli) be certified to be ready for examination for ordination, pending a call.
5. in accordance with G-14.0305e that **JENNIFER PRIOR** (a member of Paoli) be received as a Candidate.

When someone in your church is interested in ordination and coming under care of the Presbytery of Donegal the following steps will assure that they are mentored and guided as they grow in the faith and make decisions about their future calling:

- Determine that the individual has been an active member of your congregation for minimum six months.
- Session notifies the chairperson of the Committee on Preparation for Ministry (CPM) of Applicant.
- **A member of the CPM visits the Session for a Session Orientation on the process.**
- ***THEN***, at a succeeding meeting the Session interviews the Applicant and makes a recommendation to the CPM.
- The CPM interviews the Applicant and makes a recommendation on enrollment as an Inquirer to the presbytery.
- The date of acceptance by the presbytery is the beginning of Inquirer Phase and, then, of the Candidate Phase.
